Setting up of Satellite Communication Terminal at Islamabad

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the fact that Pakistan Government has signed an agreement with the Chinese Government to set-up a satellite communication terminal at Islamabad;

(b) whether it is also a fact that above-mentioned satellite terminal is capable of electronic re-connaissance and possible intelligence collaboration between the two countries against India; and

(c) if the answer to parts (a) and (b) above are in the affirmative, what steps Government have taken to counter the intelligence collection from India through the satellite?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) Reports in the Pakistani Press in April 1984 state that the Peoples Republic of China Press Agency Xinhua had approached the Pakistan Government to set up satellite transmission arrangements between Islamabad and their Hong Kong regional office for the dissemination of news and that Pakistan President had offered to allot free of cost a piece of land in Islamabad for the satellite station proposed to be built by Xinhua for the flow of news from Pakistan.

(b) The Government do not have information that the above terminal will have capabilities for "electronic reconnaissance".

(c) Does not arise.
