**Primary Schools without infrastructure facilities**

2580. SHRI DWIJENDRA NATH SHARMAH: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the details of primary schools in the country, particularly in North-Eastern States, which are not having their own infrastructure, District-wise; State-wise;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) the effective measures being taken by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. (SHRIMATI) RITA VERMA): (a) to (c) As per the Sixth All India Educational Survey conducted by the NCERT in 1993, about 10.5 percent primary schools in the country were without any classroom and another 24.5% schools were having only one room for instructional purposes. The Central Government is implementing the Operation Blackboard scheme since 1987-88, the District Primary Education Programme since 1993-94 and Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) since 2001 -2002 for the improvement of infrastructure in the primary schools including construction and maintenance of school buildings, provision of toilet and drinking water facilities etc., appointment of teachers, provision of teaching-learning materials. Under Non-Lapsable Central Pool of Resources (NLCPR) funds have been released to North-Eastern States for development of infrastructure projects relating to construction/reconstruction/completion/repair and renovation of school buildings, teachers, quarters, hostels, provision for furniture teaching-learning equipments etc. Statement relating to the funds released to the North-Eastern States under the above schemes is attached.
