ITDC Establishments at Itanagar

956. SHRI NABAM REBIA: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the details of amount spent by ITDC on its establishments in Itanagar during the last three years, location-wise;

(b) the details of profit earned therefrom during this period;

(c) whether Government have formulated any scheme for development and promotion of tourism Industry in Arunachal Pradesh; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) ITDC does not have its own establishment in Itanagar. However, it has set up a Joint Venture Hotel at Itanagar in 1990 and no investment has been made during the last three years.

(b) The details of profit/loss(-) of the Joint Venture Hotel for the last three years are given below:

c) and (d) Department of Tourism, Government of India provides Central financial assistance to the State Government/UT Administrations every year for projects, identified in consultation with them for the creation of tourism infrastructure. During 1999-2000, 26 project amounting to Rs. 726.60 lakhs were sanctioned and 20 projects amounting to Rs. 296.77 lakhs have been prioritised for the year 2000-2001 for development of tourism in Arunachal Pradesh.

(b) to (d) the Golconda Fort in Andhra Pradesh, Chittorgarh and Kumbhalgarh Forts in Rajasthan have been identified by the Archaeological Survey of India for monument specific funding by donors through the National Culture Fund.
