

**Golden Quadrilateral Highways Project**

2467. SHRI PRITHVIRAJ CHAVAN: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have adopted an annuity route instead of BOT method for some of the sectors in the Golden Quadrilateral Highways Projects;

(b) if so, how many sectors have so far been awarded on an annuity basis;

(c) what is their length, cost, payment terms and also the names of the prime contractors and their consortium partners;

(d) whether Government have assumed all the traffic risk in these sections; and

(e) what is the length of highways that are planned to be offered through the annuity route?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (MAJOR GENERAL (RETD.) B.C. KHANDURI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Seven sectors have so far been awarded on annuity route.

(c) The details are given in the Statement. (*See below*)

(d) Annuity projects are different from BOT projects. In annuity projects, entrepreneurs are required to fund the project execution and maintain the same for a stated period. In return, they get periodical annuity payments. Government may however collect user fee on the sections during the period.

(e) All contracts on Golden Quadrilateral except the contracts for 86 km long Allahabad bypass have been awarded. There is no further proposal to be awarded under annuity route on Golden Quadrilateral.
