Storage of Foodgrains

- †192. SHRI KHAN GHUFRAN ZAHIDI : Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS. FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government are considering any alternative arrangement to deal with the problem of storage of foodgrains in the country: and
- (b) if so, the details thereof together with the storage capacity at present in the country ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI U.V. KRISHNAM RAJU): (a) in July. 2000. the Government of India announced National Policy on handling, storage & transportation of foodgrains. This Policy envisages private sector participation in management of foodgrains under Build-Own-Operate (BOO) scheme by development of bulk foodgrains handling storage & transportation.

(b) Storage of foodgrains is done by different agencies, *viz.*, the Food Corporation of India, the Central Warehousing Corporation and State Warehousing Corporations. The owned storage capacity available with these agencies is as under:—
