THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI V. SREENIVASA PRASAD) : (a) to (c) The details of demand, allocation and lifting of edible oils for the PDS in respect of Andhra Pradesh for the last three years are as follows :

(d) and (e) The main reason cited by the States, including Andhra Pradesh, for the poor offtake of edible oils is the lower level of open market prices *vis-a-vis* the Central Issue Price (CIP) of edible oils. In the past the Central Government has reduced the CIP in order to encourage the States to improve their offtake performance. At present, however, there is no import or allocation of edible oils for the PDS.
