THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRIMATI BIJOYA CHAKRAVARTY): (a) to (c) An agreement has been signed with the World Bank on 15.3.2002 for credit of SDR 110 million equivalent to US\$ 140 million for "Rajasthan Water Sector Restructuring Project". The project is likely to benefit about 2,50,000 farm families directly and stimulate additional demand for labour estimated at about 29,000 jobs per year.
