THE MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SHANTA KUMAR): (a) to (c) A Central Team visited some of the affected districts in Andhra Pradesh, in May, 2002. The Team recomended allocation of foodgrains for Food for Work Programme in 8 districts. Taking into account the recommendations of the Team and subsequent to the visit of the Team, 5 lakh MTs of foodgrains in the month of May and 5 lakh MTs of foodgrains for the month of June were allocated to the State under the special component of the Sampooran Grameen Rozgar Yojana to complete the incomplete works of the erstwhile Food for Work Programme.
