Out of 17 RECs, 10 RECs have already adopted the new MOA/Rules & Government of India has declared them (10 RECs) 'Deemed to be Universities' with full academic autonomy. They have been renamed as National Institute of Technologies (NITs). Remaining 7 RECs will be declared 'Deemed to be University' and renamed as NITs, as and when they adopt the new MOA/Rules and complete other formalities.
