THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI D. PURANDESWARI): (a) to (c) The University Grants Commission (UGC) identified Universities with potential for excellence and provides financial assistance to them, up to a limit of Rs. 30 crores over a period of five years, in order to improve the quality of higher education. It is also implementing a Special Assistance Programme (SAP) wherein assistance of Rs. 40-100 lakhs is given to eligible Department of Universities having a potential for quality teaching and research in various disciplines.

The National Assessment and Accredited Council (NAAC), an autonomous inter-university centre of the UGC, assesses and accredits institutions of higher education with a view to improving their quality.

A programme of Finishing Schools for unemployed engineering graduates has been taken up since 2007-08 in order to prepare them for the IT/ITeS industries.
