THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI V. RADHIKA SELVI): (a) Some of the major recommendations suggested in the report, *inter-alia*, include, suggestions relating to reclassification of crimes with the objective of empowering victims, speedy and efficacious delivery of justice, sentencing guidelines for purposive punishment, safeguarding the interest of the weaker sections, use of science and technology for Criminal Justice Reforms and compensation for victims etc.

(b) and (c) As the criminal law and criminal procedure falls in the concurrent list of the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India, and as the recommendations of the Committee have wide ranging implications, copies of the Report have been sent to all the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations for their views and suggestions. Only the States of Haryana, Sikkim and Orissa and Union Territories of Puducherry and A & N Administration have responded. Taking a view on the report is subject to receipt of comments from the State Governments and the Central Government further taking a holistic view on the recommendations for which no time frame can be fixed.
