Funds are being allocated to Rail Vikas Nigam Ltd. (RVNL) continuously. In the Budget for the year 2008-09, it has been proposed to allot Rs. 1535 crore to RVNL under different Plan Heads.

. THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) The new BG line from Patan-Bhiladi is already sanctioned as apart of Viramgam-Bhiladi gauge conversion project. Preliminary activities like preparation of plan, estimates, etc. are in progress.

The portion of Patan-Bhiladi does not come under the identified alignment of the Western route of Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC). However, Mehsana-Viramgam-Surendranagar-Pipavav (395 kms) is an identified feeder route for the Western Freight
