

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI E.V.K.S. ELANGO VAN): (a) to (c) The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh *vide* letter dated 13.07.2007 requested the Government of India regarding introduction of Minimum Support Price (MSP) for the mulberry cocoons and to fix Rs. 100/- per kg. for Multivoltine cocoons and Rs. 150/- per kg. for Bivoltine cocoons. Government of India has asked Central Silk Board to obtain the views of other States and suggest a comprehensive and workable scheme alongwith mechanism for its implementation.

Handloom Export Zone

2633. SHRIMATI KANIMOZHI: Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has any proposal to set up nation's first Handloom Export Zone (HEZ);

(b) if so, the details thereof and the location identified for setting up of the same;

(c) whether it is also proposed to extend the same to other parts of the country particularly in Tamil Nadu;

(d) whether there is also proposal to set up export panel for preparing fibre policy; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI E.V.K.S. ELANGO VAN): (a) and (b) The Handloom Export Promotion Council has started implementing Handloom Export Zone project in Nagercoil, Kancheepuram, Thiruvannamalai, Nagapattinam and Thiruvallur with the financial aid from State agencies. These projects aim to establish Common Facility Centres, increase productivity and quality of handloom products and loom upgradation. These projects will create a supply hub for home textile for 'export markets with trained' workforce.

(c) The Handloom Export Promotion Council has started implementing all the five Handloom Export Zone projects in the State of Tamil Nadu. Presently, there is no proposal with the Government to extend the same to other parts of the country.

(d) and (e) There is no proposal to set up export panel for preparing fibre policy.
