Import of soda ash

2484. SHRI SURENDRA MOTILAL PATEL: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that more soda ash import is being made due to reduction in import duty;

(b) if so, the steps being taken or proposed to be taken to protect the domestic manufacturer of soda ash industry; and

(c) what steps Government proposes to increase soda ash production as soda ash is an intermediate product used in the production of soap, detergent, glass, colour, dye-stuff and other chemicals?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL POLICY AND PROMOTION, MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI ASHWANI KUMAR): (a) to (c) soda ash is delicensed and 100% FDI is permitted to encourage domestic production. Import of soda ash is free. Existing customs duty on soda ash is 7.5%. There is no reduction in duty during 2008-09. The shortfall in the production of soda ash in 2006-07 was due to closure of one of the manufacturers of soda ash for few months. The domestic production, import and export of soda ash for last four years is as follows:—

It may be seen from the latest export price of Rs. 7644 per MT is lower than the import price of Rs. 8216 per MT indicating competitiveness of Indian soda ash industry.
