(a) whether it is a fact that corporates and multi-nationals are making campus selections in IITs and IIMs, by offering attractive salaries and perks;

(b) if so, the details of direct selection made by them during 2006 and 2007; and

(c) the steps being taken to bring in brilliant talent into public services?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) It is a fact that multinational and Indian private sector companies recruit a substantial number of students of IITs and IIMs through campus selection.

(c) Recruitment to public services is done based on all relevant considerations including the intellectual ability of the applicants.
