THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI A.K. ANTONY): (a) The Indian Armed Forces personnel are deployed in six UN Peace Keeping Missions viz., Congo, Lebanon, Ethiopia-Eritrea, Sudan, Golan Heights and Ivory Coast, at present

A total of 8887 Indian Armed Forces! personnel are presently deployed in UN Peace keeping operations and UN Headquarters, New York. The terms and conditions of the personnel deployed in these missions are governed by the orders/instructions issued by the UN and Government of India including Memorandum of Understanding/ Letter of Assist signed between UN and Government of India.

Each peacekeeping mission is governed by UN mandate which is reviewed from time to time.

Protection of strategic interests in Indian Ocean Region

2064. SHRI GIREESH KUMAR SANGHI: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

are India's growing strategic interest for unhindered economic interests in the Indian Ocean Region well protected and are adequate reconnaissance aircrafts and long-range fighters having logistic support from aircraft carrier and dedicated comparable smaller versions deployed at well-identified points;

if so, does the Naval Formations also provide requisite protection to our off-shore oil exploration platform; and

did any foreign intrusion in Indian Ocean Region occur during 2005 and 2006?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI A.K. ANTONY): (a) and (b) India's strategic and economic interests in Indian Ocean Region are well protected and the Indian Navy and the Coast Guard are geared upto ensuring the safety of India's maritime interests. Adequate reconnaissance and surveillance of the sea areas of India's interest is also maintained by both shore-based and ship-borne surveillance aircraft. Indian Navy's ships and aircraft undertake regular patrols to ensure the safety of the country's off-shore oil exploration platforms.

(c) There is no information of any intrusion in the Indian Ocean Region during the years 2005 and 2006.
