Central University status to Utkal University

(a) whether it is proposed to grant Central University status to Utkal University of Orissa, as it now satisfies all the norms for the purpose; and

(b) what is the time-frame within which the above demand of the State Government would be agreed to and approval conveyed to the State Government?

Setting up of 16 Central Universities one each in States which do not have a Central University at present, has been included in the Eleventh Plan. Orissa is one of the 16 States.
