13164. SHRI JABIR HUSAIN: Will the Minister of HOME

AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) in its latest report resented several serious facts and data regarding crimes against women and their trafficking; and

(b) if so, the status of crimes against women as per report, State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (DR. SHAKEEL A<u>HMAD</u>): (a)-National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) in its latest Crime in India report has a chapter each on crime against women and human trafficking.

(b) The State/UT-wise information on cases registered, cases charge-sheeted, cases convicted, persons arrested, persons charge-sheeted and persons convicted under various heads of crime against women, including trafficking, in 2006 is given in the Annexure [See Appendix 213 Annexure No. 11] A total of 164765 cases of crimes against women, which includes 4541 cases booked under the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, were reported in the country during 2006.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (DR. SHAKEEL AHMAD): (a) and (b) in terms of the statutes and rules governing the 'Padma Awards':

- (0 Padma Vibhushan is given for 'exceptional and distinguished service',
- (ii) Padma Bhushan for 'distinguished service of a high order', and
- (iii) Padma Shri for 'distinguished service'.

The awards are broadly given in the fields of Art, Social Work, Public Affairs, Science & Engineering, Trade & Industry, Medicine, Literature & Education, Civil Service, Sports etc. There is no separate category specifically earmarked for the Chiefs of Public Sector Undertakings.
