Abandoned aerodromes in North-Eastern Region

3817. SHRI KHAGEN DAS : Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :

(a) the policy of Government regarding abandoned aerodromes spread all over the country;

(b) the number of such aerodromes in the North-Eastern Region, State-wise;

(c) whether Government propose to open the closed Airport at Tripura; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV) :
(a) A new Civil Aviation Policy is under formulation which will, among other things, also address the issue of abandoned aerodromes spread all over the country.

(b) The non-operational aerodromes in the North-East Region are Rupsi and Sheila in Assam, Kailashahar, Kamalpur and Khowai in Tripura and Tural in Mizoram.

(c) and (d) No, Sir. There is no proposal to operationalise the closed airport in Tripura since no airline has made any demand to operate from such airports.
