- 4109. SHRI K.C. KONDAIAH: Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Central Government have stopped its share of Rs. 291 lakh to Karnataka as Marketing De^'elopment Assistance from 1st April, 2000 for giving rebate, infrastructure development and assistance to weavers in Karnataka;
 - (b) if so, the reasons for stopping the assistance;
- (c) whetlier it has come to the notice of the Government that discontinuing this assistance would affect 71,238 weavers in Karnataka; and
- (d) whether Government would take steps to reconsider its decision and release its share for 2000-2001 as before?
