- (b) if so. whether keeping in view this fact Government are contemplating to formulate any new employment oriented scheme; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS AND PUBLIC GRIEVANCES OF THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS (SHRI ARUN SHOURIE): (a) National Sample Surveys show that unemployment reduced from 2.62 per cent of labour force in 1987-88 to 1.90 per cent in 1993-94, and further to 1.81 per cent in 1997.

(b) and (c) A number of schemes to increase work opportunities for low income groups and weaker sections exist. Some of these have been restructured recently. A new scheme called Pradhan Mantri Gramodaya Yojana (PMGY) is being introduced from the current year which will create new opportunities for employment.
