Spread of Brain Haemorrhage

(a) whether it is a fact that the disease of brain haemorrhage is spreading rapidly among people in different parts of the country;

(b) if so, whether Government have taken any steps so far to check it; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI N.T SHANMUGAM) : (a) Even though adequate data is not available, increase in cases of brain haemorrhage is shown in all countries. Two relevant factors are: increasing urbanisation and changing life-style.

(b) and (c) The Government has undertaken pilot project on Cardiovascular Disease (CVD) Programme in 5 States to assess the level of awareness and risk factors in selected population.

During the year 1998-99 Rs. 49.50 lakhs were given in AIIMS to carry out CVD (Cardiovascular Control and Prevention Activities) in the organised sector e.g. CGHS, Railways etc.
