## Manufacturing of Aerotyres for IAF

## 1369. SHRI NILOTPAL BASU: SHRI DIPANKAR MUKHERJEE:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state;

- (a) whether the aerotyres for Indian Air Force are manufactured in Sahaganj Unit of Dunlop India Limited (DIL) only;
  - (b) if not, the name of other indigenous manufactures;
  - (c) type of aircrafts where aerotyres are used;
- (d) quantity of aerotyres imported after the suspension of work in Sahaganj Unit;
- (e) financial implications viz. foreign exchange outgo and higher cost incurred on this account; and
- (f) the steps taken by Government to resume and sustain optimal production in Dunlop unit to serve defence interest?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI HARIN PATHAK): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) Aerotyres are being used in 16 types of service aircrafts,

including helicopters.

- (d) Total number of tyres imported are approximately 11400.
- (e) the total cash outgo for imports is Rs. 11.05 crores approximately and the higher cost incurred over Dunlop rates is estimated to be Rs. 1.20 crores.
- (f) The matter of revival of Dunlop is before the Board for Financial and Industrial Reconstruction.

## Armed Forces Association with Committee on Security Groups
