- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRIMATI JAYAWANTI MEHTA): (a) to (e) Government of India is committed to fully develop the untapped hydro-electric potential in Himachal Pradesh. Based on the request received from Himachal Pradesh, Power Finance Corporation have sanctioned 3 loans amounting to Rs. 949.66 lakhs for survey and investigation in Satluj, Yamuna and Ravi Basins. Government of India has also recently sanctioned Rs. 77.62 crores for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) and for pre-construction activities and development of infrastructure for Parbati-II HE project (800 MW) in Himachal Pradesh by National Hydroelectric Power Corporation. Efforts are being made to avail World Bank assistance for survey and investigation and preparation Bankable DPRs for hydroelectric projects in Himachal Pradesh on Satluj and Ravi Basins. The DPR for Rampur HEP (580 MW) is also being formulated by Nathpa Jhakri Power Corporation with World Bank assistance.

(c) Close monitoring is being done by Ministry of Power for timely completion of projects through Empowered Committee and Task Forces constituted for this purpose. For private sector projects, a Crisis Resolution Group has been set up to resolved the 'last mile' problems.
