Financial Assistance to State Governments for Natural Calamities

4890. SHRI R.S. GAVAI: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the financial assistance sought by the State Governments and released by Government for natural calamities such as floods, cyclones and landslides during last five years, State-wise;

(b) whether any such demand is pending before Government;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) Government's reaction thereto?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI SUNDER LAL PATWA): (a) to (d) In addition to yearly allocation during 1995-96 to 1999-2000 under Calamity Relief Fund (CRF) to undertake immediate relief measures in the wake of various natural calamities, assistance from the National Fund for Calamity Relief (NFCR) was considered for calamities of rare severity in accordance with a set procedure and the admissibility norms. Assistance from the NFCR released to various States during 1995-96 to 1999-2000 in wake of various natural calamities is indicated in the statement annexed. (*See next page*) No request from the States for assistance from NFCR is pending for 1999-2000.
