Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) when the last livestock census was undertaken in the country;

(b) what is the population of cows, buffaloes, goats, sheeps, and its progeny and other cattle in the country, State-wise;

(c) whether it is a fact that the cattle population is decreasing rapidly, per one thousand citizens of India; and

(d) if so, what is the number of cattle population per thousand in 1951, 1961, 1971, 1981 and 1991, State- wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI SBPBK SATYANARAYANA RAO): (a) The last livestock census was conducted in 1997. However, data by this census is not yet available as the census reports from a large number of States/UTs have not been received so far;

(b) Details indicating the total number of livestock are giving in the Annexure. [See Appendix 189, Annexure No. 122]

(c) At all India level cattle population against per one thousand human population is showing a decreasing trend.

(d) After independence livestock censuses were conducted during 1951, 1956, 1961, 1966, 1972, 1977, 1982, 1987 and 1992. A statement indicating the cattle population during 1951, 1961, 1972, 1982 and 1992 against per thousand human population is given in the Annexure. [See Appendix 189, Annexure No. 122]
