**Damage to Railway Property During Bihar Bund**

5150. SHRI RAVI SHANKAR PRASAD: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether any damage to the Railway property was caused during the bund organised in Bihar to protest against swearing in of the NDA Government in the State in March, 2000;

(b) whether any estimate has been made of the amount of loss suffered by Railways as result thereof;

(c) if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether any action has been taken or is proposed to be taken against the persons responsible for the loss; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

(c) Railway property worth Rs. 299 Lakhs and Rs. 68,60,942/- was damaged in Eastern and North Eastern Railway respectively.

(d) Yes, Sir.

(e) Civil police and GRP have registered cases against the persons responsible for the loss under various section of IPC and the Railway Act, Five cases have been registered in the jurisdiction of North Eastern Railway.
