(a) whether it is a fact that establishment of Navodaya Vidyalayas have helped in maintaining the level of secondary education in the country;

(b) whether Government would consider to encourage establishment of more Navodaya Vidyalayas in the country; and

(c) the number of Navodaya Vidyalayas established in the country till March, 2000 and the names of States whose each district does not have even one Navodaya Vidyalaya so far?
