THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR): (a) During the last three years i.e. 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99, twenty five (25) electronic exchanges have been set up in Arunachal Pradesh.

(b) For the first four years of the Ninth Plan the target is for 28 exchanges. For the last year of the plan (2001-2002) the target will be 7.

(c) All necessary steps like procurement of land, construction of building, procurement of equipment and other stores are being done to achieve the targets.
