Pakistani Army has also carried out certain troop readjustments on the Line of Control and some reserve formations have also been moved from their permanent locations closer to the Line of Control.

The Kargil misadventure by Pakistan resulted in a major defeat for that country, both on diplomatic and the military front. As a face saving measure, they have embarked upon a renewed campaign to step up militancy in J&K, to prove to the world that J&K continues to remain a "flash point" requiring intervention by the International community.

With the accession of Gen. Pervez Musharraf to the position of Chief Executive of Pakistan, Islamic fundamentalists have been given all the encouragement and support to step up terrorism in Kashmir in the name of "Jehad". This includes targetting of Police Personnel and Security Forces sympathisers, suicide attacks on Security Forces camps, minority killings and spreading terror through bomb attacks in public places. However, the Security Forces are adequately geared up to frustrate the designs of the terrorists.

A suicide bomber did attempt to enter the Badami Bagh Cantonment in Srinagar on 19 April, 2000. However, he could not succeed in his mission due to the alertness of the sentries and had to prematurely detonate the car bomb, thereby killing himself and injuring a few security personnel and civilians.

Briefings on developments take place from time to time. It would not be in public interest to divulge the details of such briefings.

Creation of Kalinga Regiment
