**Assistance for Rural Unemployed Youths in U.P.**

5619. PROF. M.M. AGARWAL: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to grant financial assistance to the unemployed youths to provide them self-employment opportunities in the rural areas of Uttar Pradesh; and

(b) if so, the total funds allocated and released for the same during the last five years, year-wise?

THE MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUNDER LAL PATWA): (a) Financial assistance in the form of subsidy and bank credit is provided for self-employment of persons belonging to Below Poverty Line (BPL) families in all rural areas including those of Uttar Pradesh under the on-going Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY). SGSY was launched w.e.f. 1.4.1999. Before that such assistance were provided under the erstwhile Integrated Rural Development Programme (IRDP).
