THE MINISTER OF STATE OF DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL AND TRAINING, AND DEPARTMENT OF PENSIONS AND PENSIONERS' WELFARE OF THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS (SHRIMATI VASUNDHARA RAJE): (a) and (b) The details of posts in different Groups that are lying vacant for the period from March 1999 to March 2000 is not available. However, according to the data published by the Pay Research Unit of the Ministry of Finance, the number of the posts that were lying vacant in Central Government offices as on 31-03-1998 was 3,45,686. The Group-wise and the Ministry-wise distribution of the posts lying vacant as on 31 -3-98 is enclosed as Statement I and II (*See* below).

(c) Need based recuitment is being made by the concerned Ministries after taking into account the operational regurements and the Government instructions in this regard.

(d) This information is not maintained centrally.
