GRIEVANCES OF THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS (SHRI ARUN SHOURIE): (a) to (d) The Planning Commission has commenced work on the preparation of a National Human Development Report. A Steering Committee under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Planning Commission has been set up to oversee the work. The report is expected to be submitted to the Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission by the end of the financial year 2000-2001.

## Impact of New Export-Import Policy on SSI Units

3057. SHRI VAYALAR RAVI: Will the Minister of SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES AND AGRO AND RURAL INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have made any evaluation of the impact of the new export-import policj' on the SSI units ; and
  - (b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SMAIX SCALE INDUSTRIES AND AGRO AND RURAL INDUSTRIES (SHRIMATI VASUNDHAK\ RAJE): (a) and (b) Removal of Quantitative Restrictions in respect of several SSI reserved items under the new EXIM Policy would result in increased competition from imported goods. The Government is assisting the SSI sector to meet the emerging challenges by providing support in the areas of credit, technology, design, quality contiol, standards and marketing.

## Implication of the quota restrictions

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES AND AGRO AND RURAL INDUSTRIES (SHRIMATI VASUNDHARA RAJE): (a) and (b) The Small Scale Industries in India have enough resilience to withstand the impact of phasing out of Quantitative Restrictions beyond April, 2000, as is evident from their recent track record.
