

Reopening of Adilabad Unit of CCI

357. DR. Y. LAKSHMI PRASAD: Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the employees unions of the Cement Corporation of India have demanded to re-open the Adilabad Unit of the CCI;

(b) if so, the action taken in this regard;

(c) whether Government propose to grant Rs. 287 crore package for the CCI which has been referred to BIFR; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (DR. VALLABHBHAI RAMJIBHAI KATHIRIA): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Operations of Adilabad and a few other units of CCI remain suspended due to disconnection of power supply, liquidity and other problems of the Corporation. The company has been under reference to BIFR. BIFR has been considering a fresh Draft Revival Scheme.

(c) and (d) Government's response can be decided only after examining the Draft Revival Scheme (DRS) when it is circulated by the BIFR.

The number of Public Sector Enterprises in other States are 234.
