comparison of these systems is not valid. Indian Railways do not have any definite data regarding Chinese Railways.

Progress on Chandigarh—Ludhiana Rail Line

3789. SARDAR BALWINDER SINGH BHUNDAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased as state whether any progress has been made on Chandigarh—Ludhiana, via Morinda, rail line for which the Railways Minister had laid stone at the time of inauguration, at Mohali last year?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH): The progress is as follows:

- (i) Rs. 3.5 crore have been deposited with the State Govt. of Punjab for acquisition of land. Part of land required for the project is expected to be available by Sept. 2000.
- (ii) Rs. 1.15 crore has also been deposited with Union Territory Administration of Chandigarh for acquisition of land. The land is expected to be available by June, 2000, after removal of encroachments.
- (iii) The Geotechincal investigations, preparation of drawings and calling of tenders are in progress.

The work will start after the land is handed over to the Railways by the concerned authorities.
