**Impact of IA summer schedule on tourist arrival at Leh**

584. SHRI KUSHOK THIKSEY: Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that due to unavailability of seats and late declaration of Indian Airlines summer schedule to Leh has adverse impact on the foreign tourists visiting Ladakh every summer causing huge foreign exchange loss to the nation; and

(b) whether the Ministry of Tourism has taken up the matter with Civil Aviation Ministry in this regard and if so, the details thereof and the corrective measures taken?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND THE MINISTER OF CULTURE (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) There has been ups and downs in the foreign tourists visiting Ladakh over years. Figures of tourist arrivals in Ladakh for the last ten years are as follows:—

According to information available from Indian Airlines, in addition to the scheduled services to Leh, additional services between Delhi and Leh are operated every year during June-September and schedule of additional service is announced in early March itself. They have, however, indicated that seat factors for last three years on Delhi/Leh/Delhi services during April-September has varied between 50—60% only.
