Funds to Madhya Pradesh for RD Schemes

280. SHRI RAGHAVJI: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) what is year-wise and scheme-wise amount of funds sent by Central Government to Madhya Pradesh during the last three years, under various schemes for rural development;

(b) the improvement made in rural development in the State with the above funds; and

(c) whether any assessment has been made in this regard; if so, what has been the outcome thereof; if not, whether any such assessment would be made?

THE MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUNDER LAL PATWA): (a) to (c) The amount of funds released by the Ministry of Rural Development to Madhya Pradesh for implementation of its schemes during 1996-97 to 1998-99 is indicated at enclosed Statement I (See below). The physical achievements under these Schemes in the State during these three years have been indicated at enclosed Statement II. (See below). A quick evaluation of selected programmes is proposed to be done in all States, including Madhya Pradesh in the current year.
