

**Review of anti-poverty programmes**

278. SHRI ANANTA SETHI: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether any review of implementation of various anti-poverty programmes in the country during Eighth Five Year Plan has been made;

(b) if so, the State-wise details thereof;

(c) whether Government propose to spend more funds these programmes for the backward States like Orissa in the Ninth Five Year Plan;

(d) if so, the details of allocation made to that State during 1999-2000 financial year; and

(e) the details of allocation made to other States for the same purpose in the current financial year?

THE MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUNDERLAL PATWA): (a) and (b) All the anti-poverty programmes are being reviewed regularly. The achievements in terms of physical progress and financial performance vary from State to State.

(c) Information is being collected.
