5. Regional and sub-regional offices of wildlife preservation have been set up mostly at the main export centres of the country to prevent smuggling of wildlife products.

6. Interdepartmental co-ordination has been enhanced with other enforcement organisation like police, BSF, customs, ITBP, coast guard etc. Training programme on enforcement of Wildlife (Protection) Act is also conducted.

7. Staff in national parks and sanctuaries are being provided modern arms, wireless equipments and communication facilities to check poaching in the national parks and sanctuaries.

8. Analogous to the Centre, the states have also been asked to set up co-ordination Committee of all enforcement agencies so that there is effective co-operation to check poaching and control of illegal trade.

Effect of displacement of Tribals on the Forests

†426. SHRI JANESHWAR MISRA: Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that considerable loss is being caused to the forests/wild animals on account of the tribals being displaced from forests and their entry into the sanctuaries being restricted under Forest (Conservation) Act;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether Government would enact any alternative law to ensure that inter-dependence between the forests and the inhabitants of forests is revived?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI BABU LAL MARANDI): (a) No Sir.

(c) Legislation of any alternative law to revive the inter-dependence between the forest and the inhabitants of forest is not stipulated. The objective is being achieved through implementation of Joint Forest Management and Eco Development programmes through participatory management.
