(b) the total number of cattle perished in the above village;

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI S.B.P.B.K. SATYANARAYANA RAO): (a) As reported by the State Government, two persons died in Panchapalli village due to Super cyclone.

(b) 320.

(c) 922 fully and 108 partially. Individual details are not yet available.

(d) 350 acres.

(e) Special repair in this stretch has been undertaken. Trucks and other four wheelers are plying on the road.

(f) Funds have been placed at the disposal of the Collector, Jagatsinghpur to provide ex-gratia and house building grant.
