

Foreign investment in expansion of ports

747. SHRI ANANTA SETHI: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have a proposal to make Foreign Direct Investment in the development, expansion and modernisation of port;

(b) if so, the port-wise plan investment proposed thereon;

(c) the specific plan formulated for Paradip Port in that regard; and

(d) the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (DR. DEBENDRA PRADHAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) No port-specific plan for Foreign Direct Investment is proposed. However, projects have been identified for private sector participation which are open for foreign investment as well.
