

Raising standard of Scientific Research

1105. SHRI P. PRABHAKAR REDDY: Will the Minister of SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news-item appearing in the Hindustan Times dated 13th November, 1999 under the caption Indian Scientific Research Flagging which paints a despondent picture about the research activities in the industrial, scientific and educational establishments in our country; and

(b) if so, the reaction of Government thereto and the steps proposed to step up the standard of research and scientific studies in various universities and centres of advance learning?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY OF THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI BACHI SINGH RAWAT 'BACHDA'): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Government have always placed high emphasis on constantly improving standards of research and development actively. Some recent initiatives relating to young scientist and science education are: the Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana, the Swarnajayanti Fellowships, biotechnology Fellowships and the proposed Fund for Improvement of Infrastructure in Universities and other higher educational institutions.
