

Telephone Connections in Post Offices of Meghalaya

1243. SHRI ONWARD L. NONGTDU: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether telephone connection have been provided in all the post offices of Meghalaya;

(b) if so, the number of post offices yet to be provided with this facility; and

(c) by when this facility is likely to be provided to such post offices in the State during the Ninth Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR): (a) and (b) No, Sir. In Meghalaya out of 480 Post Offices including extra-departmental Sub & Branch Post Offices, 54 Post Offices including extra-departmental Post Offices have telephone facilities leaving 426 post offices without telephone facilities.

(c) Attempts are being made by the Telecom authorities to provide telephone on demand by the end of Ninth Plan. Telephone connections are provided to Post Offices on the demand placed subject to availability of resources.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR): (a) Yes, Sir.
