

Setting up of Navodaya and Central Schools

1773. SHRI DILIP SINGH JUDEV: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the year-wise number of new Navodaya Vidyalayas and Central Schools set up during 1995-96 to 1998-99;

(b) the details rendering State-wise number of these schools;

(c) the names of the places in Madhya Pradesh where these schools have been set up as well as proposed to be set up; and

(d) the details of schools proposed to be set up during the academic year 1999-2000;

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI JAYSINGRAO GAIKWAD PATIL):
(a) and (b) A statement is annexed. (*See below*)

(c) During 1995-96 to 1998-99 no Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) has been set up in Madhya Pradesh. Five Central Schools have been set up in the State at Sidhoni, Sidhi, Morina, Bhind and Raigarh.

(d) It is endeavoured to open one JNV in each district of the country subject to receipt of suitable offer for land and temporary accommodation as per norms, from the concerned State Government. No suitable proposal fulfilling the norms for opening of a new JNV in the State of Madhya Pradesh is pending with the Samiti. No Central School is presently proposed to be set up in Madhya Pradesh during the academic year 1999-2000.
