THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI SRIRAM CHAUHAN): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. This Ministry is having following Plan Schemes for increasing the present warehousing capacity for storage of foodgrains (rice, wheat and coarse grains):—

- (i) The food Corporation of India constructs new godowns every year keeping in view the need for the Public Distribution System and availability of plan funds from the Government of India.
- (ii) The Central Warehousing Corporation constructs new warehouses for storage of agricultural produce (in addition to notified commodities, industrial goods, etc.) from out of its own resources.
- (iii) There is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for construction of godowns upto 2,000 MT Capacity especially in remote, hilly, backward and inaccessible areas for strengthening of Public Distribution System. Under this Scheme, financial assistance is given to States in the form of 50% subsidy and 50% loan.

2. Further, the Union Agriculture Ministry has recently approved a Scheme of Capital Investment Subsidy for construction/expansion/ modernisaiton of cold storages and storages for horticulture produce.
