Distribution of sugar among states

†1701. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of CON-SUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) What is the State-wise quota of levy sugar being provided by Central Government in the country;
- (b) whether the quota of sugar is provided to States on the basis of 1991 census only;
- (c) if not, what norms are being followed in providing sugar to States;
- (d) what are the reasons for providing lesser quota of sugar to Madhya Pradesh; and
- (e) by when allocation of sugar is likely to be increased on the basis of present population?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI V. SREENIVASA PRASAD:) (a), (b), (c) & (d): Under the Public Distribution System (PDS) by and large, the States/UTs including Madhya Pradesh State are supplied levy sugar calculated on uniform norm of 425 gms. per capita per month. This is currently being given as per 1991 census population & accordingly the levy sugar quota of all States/UTs. Per month works out to 3.69 lakh tonnes which is effective from 1.1.1996. In addition to above, the Government also release about one lakh tonnes per annum as festival quota which is allocated to States/UTs in the month(s) of their choice. A Statement showing State/UT-wise allocation of monthly levy quota & annual festival quota is attached. (See below)

(e) At present, it is not possible for the Central Government to increase the allocation due to the fact that the availability of levy sugar has yet to attain stability to the extent needed for allocating it on the basis of the present projected population.
