

Foodgrains In FCI Godowns

*295. SHRI DINA NATH MISHRA: Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) what is the quantum of stock of wheat and rice in the godowns of Food Corporation of India;
- (b) what is the quantum of wheat of last year's crop in the total stock of wheat and the quantum of wheat of earlier years' crops, out of the same; and
- (c) whether it is a fact that there is a serious problem of rotten wheat in the godowns of Food Corporation of India and some disagreement has arisen between Ministry of Finance and the erstwhile Ministry of Food, over the issue of disposing the same?

THE MINISTER OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI SHANTA KUMAR): (a) As on 31.10.1999 FCI had 84.94 lakh MTs of rice and 89.38 lakh MTs of wheat in its godowns; (rice includes paddy in terms of rice)

(b) Out of the 89.38 lakh MTs of wheat stocks, 21.90 lakh MTs belong to the last year's crop and the balance 67.48 lakh MTs is from the current year's crop.

(c) No Sir. The wheat stocks with FCI are of good quality and in sound condition and under scientific storage. Only about 25,000 MTs of wheat out of 89.38 lakh MTs (0.28%) has been declared as 'damaged' and is under process of disposal.
