PCO/STD/ISD Booths in Assam

- (b) 6490 applications are pending in Assam for allotment of STD/ISD/PCO booths.
- (c) The applications are pending due to various reasons such as delay in holding the meeting of the allotment Committees, non-availability of spare capacity in the exchange, non-availability of reliable media in some rural exchanges etc. However, PCO allotment Committees have been abolished.
- (d) Recently the PCO allotment policy has been revised to make available STD/ISD/PCOs freely. The measures taken to provide

more PCOs also include increase in exchange capacity for PCOs. augmenting the exchanges, provision of reliable media etc.
