- 2263. SHRI SANATAN BISI: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Cabinet Secretary is submitting from time to time the report to Government by the end of every year on implementation of various poverty alleviation programmes, meant for KBK areas of Orissa;

 (a) As per the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961, the responsibility for monitoring, reviewing and evaluating the various poverty alleviation programmes rests with the concerned Ministries/Departments, which accordingly carry out these functions. With regard to the Long Term Action Plan (LTAP) for KBK areas, the Planning Commission does the co-ordination and monitoring of the progress. The Committee of Secretaries has discussed and reviewed the programmes in eight meetings from 1993 onwards. This practice would continue.

 (a) The major poverty alleviation programmes being implemented by this Ministry in rural areas are Jawahar Gram Samridhi Yojana (JGSY), Employment Assurance Scheme (EAS), Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojna (SGSY) and Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY). These schemes are implemented in hilly and backward areas of North Eastern region also.
