Reduction of Subsidy on Cooking Gas and Kerosene

- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the extent to which it is proposed to reduce the subsidy and since when?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI E. PONNUSWAMY): (a) to (c) The Government had decided in November, 1997 that subsidy on LPG (Domestic) and Kerosene (PDS) will be reduced in phases to reach the level of 15% and 33.33% of the import parity price by 2000-01 and 20001-02, respectively. The subsidy will be transferred to the fiscal budget from the year 2002 onwards.
